School Terms

- 1- Children are not allowed to be absent throughout the school without giving prior notice. If a child is recorded absent two times without notice, he will be removed from school.
- 2- School fees for the whole year or semester have to be paid in advance before the child is accepted. If the payment is not received, no place is guaranteed for the child.
- 3- Parents are responsible for bringing their children to school and picking them up. School staff is not responsible for children after school time.
- 4- Parents are responsible for the personal hygiene of children and should cooperate with the school in refining the mannerism of their children.

Aims and Objectives

The Finsbury Park Mosque Supplementary School is a weekend school that aims to serve the Muslim community in Islington, Hackney and Haringey as well as any other students coming from other parts of London.
